

#### **Get A Short History Tour**



Tim & Elaine Harris arrived at Pine Ridge Reservation in July 1995. Coming straight from Florida, they knew no one around here and had no idea how to begin a ministry on the reservation.

Tim would drive HWY 18 on a daily basis, praying and reaching out to those the Lord put in his path. On his way he would also pass a particularly large, empty parcel of land in Oglala, SD. This piece of land was just across the street form the main housing area...

In November 1997 the Holy Spirit moved Tim's heart to search out the owner of the property. After meeting with Barbara Dull Knife they located the owner in Rushville. NE and were able to purchase 7 of the 73 acres which now sit between two major housing areas in Oglala. The Harris' had a vision of something more than just another "church" in the neighborhood; their dream was of a building and ministry that would benefit and reach out to the whole community every day.

Finally the vision took shape and the building process began. Work teams were gathered from all over the nation to do volunteer labor. By that time, a small church family had



already been born and they spent many hours getting the rough land ready for a building. Many donated materials or time in order to see the vision become reality. In August of '97 the construction of an 8,000 square foot facility was well on the way. The dream was to build a multifunctional facility including gymnasium with a kitchen area, fellowship area, bathrooms/showers, classroom space, and a 1,000 square foot apartment. The building was completed in March of 1998 and is known until today as The Oglala Re\*Creation & Worship Center, Since then, the facility and its staff have been serving the community in whatever way needed. The building has undergone many changes; in 2006 we added a 6,000 square foot multipurpose gym, and the old gym was completely renovated to serve as sanctuary, kids' church, fellowship hall and bunk housewe definitely are a work in progress!



But no matter what the changes in the building are, our vision stays the same: We want to offer a safe place for the children, and serve Jesus as "A Light In The Darkness"

#### Find Out What & Where We Are And What We Do All Day

The Re\*Creation & Worship Center is a small mission church with the Assemblies of God Home Missions in Oglala on Pine Ridge Indian Reservation, SD. Located just north of Hwy 18 and clearly visible from anywhere around, the "Rec" (as it is mostly called) is within easy walking distance of the two major housing complexes in Oglala, the Housing and Trailer Court.

We are a multi-purpose facility. open most days of the week. Our focus is on after-school kids' programs: many of the children come



straight from the school bus into the Rec or to our playground! The gym is open for kids teens, and adults to come hang out with their friends, play ball, pool, or video games, roller skate, or buy



snacks at our small concessions stand. We do not charge for the use of the building or any of its facilities. Some of our staff is always there to supervise the gym, and we

often find it a great opportunity to share Jesus in a very practical way as we build friendship with the people.



The Rec is also often used for a number of community events like birthday parties, baby showers, wakes and funerals, give-aways, sports events, weddings, etc.

In addition to that, we offer weekly Wednesday night Teen Bible Study, Kids' Church, Roval Rangers, plus Sunday morning worship services. And if that's still not enough for you,



well, we do a lot of extra stuff too! During the school year, we may take the teens hiking, the Rangers go camping, and the kids on a field trip. We try to be friends with "our" kids by attending their graduations and ball games. In the summer, our schedule is totally different; the Rec gym is open all day, and we serve free



community lunches. Some days (always a favorite!) we take the kids/teens on a swim trip. Plus, a different mission team is at the Rec almost every week doing a VBS, work project, family carnival, sports camp, bike clinic, you name it.

Apart from all that, there is always a huge amount of

cleaning and upkeep; phone calls need to be made; secretarial work demands attention. There is no shortness of opportunities to serve in God's Kingdom!
